

## RULES FOR USING THE JACUZZI AT MONTINI

For the well-being and safety of our guests, please familiarize yourself with the rules for using the Montini jacuzzi.

These rules apply to the Montini jacuzzi, including the principles of disinfection, hygiene, and preventive measures to minimize the likelihood of harmful biological factors.

1. The hot tubs in Montini are kept clean, hygienic, and disinfected.
2. The hot tubs in Montini are subjected to a series of disinfection and sanitization procedures, using professional preparations that minimize the presence of biological agents in the water.
3. Preparations used in the hot tubs:
  - Purechemical Chlorine Stabilizer is an effective powdered product that protects chlorine in pool water from decomposing too quickly under the influence of UV rays. It prolongs the action of chlorine, supports disinfection, and ensures long-lasting water purity.
  - HTH Spa Stabilized Chlorine Granules 1.2kg, Manufacturer: HTH SPA Model: Stabilized Chlorine Granules. Chlorine water disinfection, stabilized chlorine granules, is an effective disinfectant designed to effectively combat bacteria and other microorganisms in water. It is ideal for spas in both private and public facilities. Thanks to its ease of use and reliable operation, it ensures hygienic water conditions, meeting the highest standards of cleanliness. Product advantages: easy solubility – the granules dissolve quickly in water, allowing for immediate action and even distribution of active ingredients; stability – thanks to a special formula, the product is resistant to the destructive effects of UV rays and sunlight, ensuring longer-lasting effectiveness of spa water; versatility – the granules are compatible with any filtration system, making it extremely versatile; adaptation to any water type – ideal for use in both soft and hard water, without the risk of scale buildup; long-term storage – the product retains its properties for a long time when stored in a dry place and at a temperature below 40°C.
  - CHOSAPURE CHEMICAL CHLORINE STABILIZER is an ultra-pure (>99%) cyanuric acid powder that, after just one dose, protects free chlorine from sun and temperature, reducing its consumption by up to 50%. This keeps water safe, clear, and odor-free.
  - Whirlpool Bathtub Cleaner - Clean Water, model: EURO SPAS Clean Water. Extends the life of hot tubs and pools and effectively cleans hard-to-reach areas. Concentrate for thorough and effective cleaning of hoses, pumps, nozzles, and whirlpool tub surfaces. Effectively cleans hard-to-reach areas of the system. Contains ingredients that guarantee thorough and lasting cleanliness. Regular use prevents limescale, unpleasant odors, and the buildup of soap and grease residue. This product is suitable for cleaning whirlpool tubs with and without dispensers, or those with integrated cleaning systems. CHLORINE DISPENSER WITH
  - THERMOMETER FLOAT BUOY FOR POOL FOR CHLORINE TABLETS 20 G is a 2-in-1 floating dispenser that automatically releases chemicals into the pool and shows the water temperature – making bathing clean, safe and comfortable throughout the season.
4. A jacuzzi is a device for bathing in water, equipped with a water massage system. Using the device for any purpose other than its intended use is prohibited.

5. Before using the jacuzzi, slide the jacuzzi cover open using the cover mechanism. Check the water temperature by immersing your finger or part of your hand. Hydromassage is controlled solely by buttons on the panel on the white jacuzzi tub casing. After using the jacuzzi, check the water level and, if necessary, fill the jacuzzi tub with water to the required safe level (see p. 17). Close the jacuzzi cover to maintain the tub temperature (otherwise, the water will cool down and the jacuzzi bathing temperature will not be maintained).
6. Before using the Jacuzzi, wash your entire body in the shower with soap and warm water. After using the Jacuzzi, wash your body again in the shower with soap and warm water.
7. Children under 12 may only use the Jacuzzi when accompanied by an adult.
8. The jacuzzi should not be used by people with health contraindications, including: skin inflammation, fungal infections, hypersensitivity, hypertension, reduced blood clotting, kidney disease, urinary tract infections, cystitis, genital diseases, chronic diseases, circulatory system diseases, diabetes, varicose veins, open wounds, menstruation, allergy to chlorine or other swimming pool substances mentioned in point 3.
9. It is prohibited to use the jacuzzi by persons under the influence of alcohol, narcotics or medications that may affect the ability to react.
10. Remove shoes before entering the jacuzzi.
11. Enter the jacuzzi only from the stairs and handrail.
12. The person exiting the jacuzzi has priority.
13. Exercise extreme caution when exiting or entering the jacuzzi.
14. Bathing in the jacuzzi is only allowed in a sitting position.
15. Remove jewelry and other sharp objects.
16. Remain calm and do not shout. Follow safety instructions and hygiene rules.
17. If the water level in the jacuzzi no longer covers the jets or does not partially cover them, there is a risk of the jacuzzi pump shutting down or being damaged. To do this, add water from the existing water intake next to the jacuzzi using a hose and regularly maintain the water level in the jacuzzi above the jets (the water level in the jacuzzi at the time of booking the jacuzzi).
18. After exiting the jacuzzi, dry off and get dressed.
19. If you notice any irregularities, please inform the Montini reception by text message or by phone at +48 790 706 806.
20. It is recommended that jacuzzi participants have a telephone near the jacuzzi to contact them in case of emergency.
- 21. Activities prohibited in the jacuzzi include:**
  - 21.1. Creating a situation that endangers one's own safety and the safety of others using the jacuzzi, or that could cause an accident. Entering or exiting the jacuzzi other than using the steps and handrail.
  - 21.2. Standing in the jacuzzi. Immersing one's head and face.
  - 21.3. Tampering with the jets and knobs.
  - 21.4. Pouring water outside the jacuzzi.
  - 21.5. Leaving children unattended.
  - 21.6. Damaging jacuzzi equipment and fixtures.
  - 21.7. Consuming food or beverages that may inadvertently end up in the jacuzzi.
  - 21.8. Smoking or using open flames.

22. Procedure in the event of a breakdown

22.1. If you notice a drowning jacuzzi user, immediately provide assistance and, if possible, help them get out of the jacuzzi. If necessary, call the appropriate emergency services: emergency numbers:

112. Also, notify the Montini reception desk at: +48 790 706 806.

22.2. In the event of a fire, follow the fire safety instructions and call the fire brigade at the emergency number: 112.

22.3. Prolonged stay in the jacuzzi may cause overheating. Symptoms of overheating include: a sudden drop in blood pressure, dizziness, and fainting. If necessary, call the emergency services: 112.
